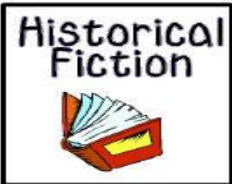

Accelerated Reader--End Of the Year Reading Day Awards

Students who make these minimum points at the end of the school year are treated to a reading reward day. The following grades need these minimum points.....

2nd graders---25 points

3rd graders---30 points

4th graders---35 points

5th graders---45 points

ANY 2ND and 3RD GRADERS REACHING 100 POINTS OR MORE

ANY 4TH AND 5TH GRADER REACHING 150 POINTS OR MORE
